Program

The Headmaster's Scholarship - Growing Scholars Award provides outstanding 1st grade students the opportunity to attend St. Andrew's recognizing their significant potential as merit scholars. The Scholarship Committee selects two recipients on the basis of the parent's application materials including the students' previous year's academic performance and teacher recommendations.

The Headmaster's Scholarship - Striving Scholars Award provides outstanding 6th grade students the opportunity to attend St. Andrew's as merit scholars. The Scholarship Committee selects two recipients on the basis of the students' application materials including previous year's academic performance, teacher recommendations, and a personal interview.

The program is open to all new students entering 1st and 6th grade in 2018-2019 and current St. Andrew's Kindergarten and 5th grade students.

Awards

Both awards will be for one academic school year, 2018-2019. Families of the Growing Scholars will be awarded \$1800, while the award for Striving Scholars will be \$2400 for the 2018-2019 school year.

Application Process

Application for a Headmaster's Scholarship is completed when you:

- Submit a St. Andrew's Application for Admission
- Collect and submit Teacher Recommendation Forms
- Submit a Headmaster's Scholarship Application Form
- Schedule a parent interview (1st) or student interview (6th)

Scholarship recipients will be notified by phone and mail by April 1.
